1. Your child's teacher needs to know whether you will be attending classes next term – as scripts and casting is being arranged now. – Please inform your child's teacher regarding this. So they are aware.

2. We would appreciate it, if your child could be as consistent in their attendance as possible, and we need you to confirm that this will be possible - poor attendance impacts both themselves and the rest of the group.

3. It is really important to help your child with any line learning they may need to do. This is an area we cannot help them with. If they feel happy and confident with their words it will give them greater overall confidence in their presentation and make it an enjoyable experience for them.

Whether the class is entered in to the exam or not - **Our aim is for the students to feel as confident and happy as possible, so as to gain a positive and enjoyable experience from presenting to an audience**. This can only happen with regular attendance and help with line learning – your job <sup>©</sup> and confidence in knowing what they are doing - our job <sup>©</sup>.

If students have to be absent please let us know before hand, so we can make any necessary adjustments to the rehearsal structure.
