

Terms and Conditions for Holiday Programmes

All parents are requested to note that admission to Centre Stage classes are subject to the conditions below and that attendance of classes, holiday programmes, workshops or activities and productions is recognition of their acceptance of these conditions.

These T&Cs are to be read in conjunction with the standard T&Cs that are on our website and refer specifically to participating in a Holiday Programme at Centre Stage. The headings in these Terms and Conditions are for reference purposes only and shall not affect the meaning or interpretation of this agreement. Centre Stage reserves the right to change its terms and conditions at any time and without notice.

Registration

Registration for a Holiday Programme can be done by email, telephone, online or completion of the registration form in the office. Once registered, the participant or their parent is required to make full payment immediately and in any event, before the Holiday Programme takes place.

By registering for the Holiday Programme, you enter into a legally-binding contract with Centre Stage to pay all fees for that programme. If you fail to pay on schedule, you agree to pay all fees (legal, collection, penalty interest, etc) and any other costs incurred by Centre Stage in recovering the debt.

Confirmation of place

A confirmation of the place in the Holiday Programme will be made via email once the payment is received and cleared. Places will be allocated on a first come first pay basis in the event of the workshop or programme being oversubscribed.

Payment of fees

Fees can be paid by credit card, NETS, cheque (made payable to Centre Stage School of the Arts Pte Ltd), bank transfer (DBS a/c 100-900244-1) or cash. A receipt is only given for cash payments.

Refunds

As we expect there to have been an informed decision regarding participation in the Holiday Programme, no refunds will be given for any reason once registered for the programme except where Centre Stage have cancelled the programme. There will be no refund given in case of closure resulting from governmental intervention.



Participation

In order to get the most out of the Holiday

Programme, the participant is expected to arrive in good time and be ready at the start time and to wrap up at the finish time. If they arrive late or leave early they are expected to do so quietly causing minimal disturbance to the other participants. The participant or their parent must inform the instructor of any such arrangements or disturbances prior to the day's starting.

Postponement & Cancellation

We reserve the right to postpone or cancel a Holiday Programme (e.g. due to insufficient registrations) in which case we will offer you an alternative Holiday Programme date or give you a full refund of all fees. We will endeavour to give as much notice of this as possible but will make a final decision no later than 12 noon on the Friday before the start of the programme.

Attendance of any Centre Stage Workshop or Show / Show rehearsal is acceptance of usage of the participant's photograph, written work and voice in academic works, brochures, videos or other promotional materials.
