But in the morning they would have had this great dinner -

And we'd describe it to each other -

Always so much better than our dinner -

Mum would get annoyed -

Cause she'd never know what was going on - Cause we'd be there laughing and whispering - And sometimes she'd try to be part of the joke - But it never really worked -

She never could be part of the joke -

Cause she didn't know what the joke was – Maybe she'd be upset by it if I told her now – Maybe she'd think we were being rude –

That in some way it was about how we didn't feel like she did enough for us –
