Just to remind you of the details of your auditions, to be held **Saturday 1**st **December & Saturday 8**th **December 2018**. **Please read carefully and note any time changes**. Each group is called for the full 3 hours on both days.

Dancing - West End Group only for their Dance Audition

Acting – Both West End and Broadway Group for their acting monologues

Singing – Both West End and Broadway Group for their solo songs

Dancing - Broadway Group only for their Dance Audition

- 1 Arrive at **8.30am** for a group warm up
- 2 On time and warmed up. Ready to start at 9.00am
- 3 Dressed in clothes suitable for movement. (Hair back and no jewelry)
- 4 Prepared.

The students will be asked to present:

- 1 Group song West End Group
- 1 x Song (memorized and prepared) West End Group
- 1 x Song (memorized and prepared) Broadway Group
- 2 Monologue (memorized and prepared) Broadway Group (Please also present all preparation)
- 1 Monologue (memorized and prepared) Broadway Group (Please also present all preparation)
- 1 Movement piece (prepared and practiced). + Pick up routine on the day

The aims of the audition are to:

- a. Give an opportunity for students to put into practice the techniques, preparation, and top tips for successful auditions, introduced & learnt during classes over the past few weeks.
- b. Give the students the experience of auditions, to build confidence, resilience and technique. (follow up debrief and reflection regarding process and experience & a report)
- c. Gauge how well the students have worked in each discipline throughout the term.
- d. Give us an indication of a student's ability to work outside of class showing the necessary skills required for auditions & performance and their approach to self-study & self-motivation.
- e. In addition, it gives us an understanding of those who show the right effort, discipline, reliability, attitude to independent learning, ability to be directed with a view to casting for productions.

This exercise is not meant to be a daunting experience but a chance for the students to show their effort and discipline and to build confidence. ©
