Ask yourself the following questions to help you work out what your character is like. Look for clues in the text, either in your own dialogue, others comments about you. Look at your own actions and behaviour or others behaviour and actions towards you. If you can't find answers to these questions in the text make up suitable answers that you think fit your characters personality.
