Firstly Congratulations on Oz - The Dance show – Great job all! Both Pete and I were really impressed by the confidence of the dancers, there has been a marked improvement and development in the Ensemble and we were both so very proud of you all. Hope you have all had a good break and are looking forward to the term ahead.

We have several pieces of information to communicate to you. Firstly, Josh has been approved leave to attend a wedding during term time May  $9^{th}$  -  $11^{th}$  and we are just in the middle of arranging cover for his classes during this time and hope that they will be covered by Daisy. Confirmation on this coming soon.

Secondly, Josh's contract comes to an end in July and we have granted him special dispensation to allow him to leave his contract early, last day June 1<sup>st</sup>, in order for him to fulfill a desire to return to the stage as a performer. He is very excited to take up the opportunity recently available to him, performing in an international Musical Theatre tour, understudying a lead role. We would like to thank Josh, for all his fabulous contributions to Centre Stage over the past 3 years. He will be missed, by colleagues, parents and students alike. His creative mind, highly skilled choreograpy and dance experience has been an inspiration. We are sure that you will join us in wishing him all the very best for the future and his onward journeys.

From June 3<sup>rd</sup> — Alice Bendall will take over till the end of term to cover Josh's classes. Alice trained with Josh at ArtsEd, after graduating worked all over the UK as a performer and voice over artist, before happily falling into Directing, Choreographing and Teaching. Alice continues to combine performing and Teaching and has recently been traveling and working around Australia. We are very much looking forward to Alice joining the team for this period.

We are also delighted that Daisy is to take over all Josh's classes, permanently from August 2019.
