Dear Parents and Dancers,

Each year, with the exception of last, we stage a large scale Ballet Performance at an Outside Venue, in order to give students the opportunity to perfect and perform on the big stage. We are thrilled to formally announce our Annual Ballet Performance this year is scheduled to take place on **Saturday 25th May 2019** at the **Gateway Theatre (with 2 performances at 2pm and 4.30pm)** and we are delighted to invite your child to perform.

Attached to this letter is the full rehearsal schedule. As ever, involvement in the show will require discipline and commitment to rehearsals - which will take place both in class with some extra rehearsals on weekends, and weekdays, as the show approaches. We would therefore ask that you ensure your child can attend **all** classes and rehearsals before registering for the show. As you can imagine, a project of this size takes meticulous planning and we need consistency of attendance from all concerned to make sure it is a success. Our primary concern is for our students to have a wonderful experience on-stage and this can only be achieved if they feel confident and well rehearsed.

Show Fee: The cost for taking part in the show this year will be **\$450** for older Students (Grades 1-8*) and **\$320** for our younger students (Grades - Beginner, Pre Primary, Primary & Discover Dance*) for which you will receive:

- 1 Full Costume (to the value of \$60)
- 2 Tickets to the show
- Upwards of 30 hours of extra rehearsals for Grades 1-8, and 20+ for younger students

This show fee also helps to contribute to production costs: set, lighting, sound, licensing, insurance, music rights and hire of the theatre. Centre Stage will absorb all remaining costs.

*Note this is the current name of your child's class, not the grade they are due to move up to next academic year.

A note from Pete re budget: I would like to add a very brief note re budget. Ali and I believe that the performance element of our work is crucial to the development of the students. It doesn't sit well with us to have to charge dancers to perform; after all, we are performers ourselves and believe that it should be the other way around. Obviously in a training environment however, this simply doesn't add up, as it is impossible to sell enough tickets to finance a show. Theatres in Singapore are very expensive (the one we are in for this show is running close to \$10,000 for just the two days and that is before including all the other costs involved in producing a show.) So, we are just asking for a few things:

- a) Your understanding as to why we have to charge
- b) Your enthusiasm for encouraging friends and family to attend
- c) If any business owner or senior member would like to sponsor us, we are looking for \$5000 to defray costs.

If you are interested in finding out more about the budget, we are very happy to share. We are passionate about both the benefits of live performance and the education and development of our students; please help us to maintain these opportunities!
