

The Victim – Two Hander Scene
Stage 5 & 6 Creative Drama Class Presentation

In The School Gym Changing Rooms

(Peeps out from underneath the changing room benches, crawls out and stands up)

A: Phew! They've gone

A: *(Puffing up their chest to look and feel brave as they say the next lines are spoken as if to their Bully)* Just leave me alone!, Pick on some one else ok! Just go away! Now!

B: *(B enters just to hear A saying 'Just go away! Now!')* What?! Me! Why?! A: Sorry! Not you?

B: What are you doing here, talking to yourself?

A: I'm not Crazy! Well I don't think so! *(smiles)*

B: Are you sure?! *(smiling)*

A: Well maybe a bit! *–(pulls a funny face and acts crazy)* Bleeughtttth!

(They both laugh sit down and A tells B what the problem is)

A: I've got a problem, I'm being bullied by brusier and his gang/Fiona Mackay and her gang

B: Oh god, not him!/not her! You are in big trouble! Poor you!

A: Thanks! I told you it's a problem!

B: Why are they bullying you?

A: Lots of reasons – I have to do their homework they take my lunch money.

B: That's terrible why don't you tell some one?

A: I can't tell mum as I've been taking money from the change pot in the kitchen to pay them and I'll be in such trouble with her.

B: I guess she'll find out eventually when she notices the money going missing

A: Yep I guess so! –..... I know if I could just avoid him/her till home time, run on to the bus I can get home(thinks) then I could just pretend to be sick tomorrow which is Friday, then I've got Saturday and Sunday before I have to worry about seeing him/her till Monday.

B: Yeah but you'll have to face them on Monday and the next day and the next day. I think you should tell someone.

A: I could just stick with you and all my other friends all the time? That might work?

B: That won't stop him/her – he/she is so mean and nasty

A: And all the gang that follows him/her are just as bad

B: I don't know why they follow him/her he/she treats them so badly

A: I guess they are as scared as me and just can't stand up to him/her

B: Well we need to tell someone and stand up to them - Let's practice

A: That's what I was doing when you came in

B: Oh! I see. Well try again, go on.

A: *(Puffing up their chest to look and feel brave as they say the next lines as if to their Bully)* Just leave me alone!, Pick on some one else ok! Just go away! Now!

B: Great and again!

A: *(Puffing up their chest to look and feel brave as they say the next lines as if to their Bully But with much more confidence)* Just leave me alone!, Pick on some one else ok! Just go away! Now!Oh No! Oh No!...

B: No you sound scared again

A: No! Look! Here they come

B: Oh no! Remember – be strong

A: *(A tries to puff up chest and says to themselves)* come on you can do it.... Just leave me....

(Gang arrive)

A: Just leave me alone!

B: yeah Just leave/him/her alone

A& B – Pick on someone else Ok! Just go away! NOW! *(A&B both look pleased and relieved)*

(Then a beat later – as they react to the look on the bullies face)

B: oh no!...Duck! *(A & B Duck and put hands up to protect their face- just as Bully pulls back fist to punch and Freeze the action)*

OR

Bully runs and A & B Cheer

(Alternative ending – both can be played and audience chooses or class chooses the one the prefer before hand and perform that one)
