

When 11 year old Jack is struggling to revise for his science test he calls on his friend the Catalysts to come and give him a hand. These dozen or so science boffins have no problem helping him understand forces, the planets and the solar system, friction, gravity, pressure, speed and much more!

Jack and the Catalysts is the first in a highly successful series of four plays which Tring Park school regularly tour around Hertfordshire and Buckinghamshire primary schools in the UK. All of the plays are written by the school's Director of Drama Edward Applewhite, and all include Key Stage 2 (Primary) science subjects. This particular play, Jack and the Catalysts lasts approximately 50 minutes and is ideally suitable for year 3 to 6 (7-11) but it has been performed to younger pupils too. It contains songs and audience participation and presents science in an informative but entertaining way. It is usually performed in a school hall is completely self contained, requiring a set up of 25 minutes and can be struck and cleared away in 15.
