

# RE: Annual Dance Show February 2020 The Seven Deadly Sins

Dear Parents and Dancers,

Each year we stage a large scale Dance Show at an Outside Venue, giving students the chance to showcase their talents on the big stage. We are thrilled to formally announce our Annual Dance Performance this year is scheduled to take place on **Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020** at the **Gateway Theatre** (with 2 performances 2pm and 4.30pm shows) and are delighted to invite your child to perform in this exciting show! The Seven Deadly Sins will be a fabulous festival of Dance, incorporating Jazz, Tap, Contemporary, Ballet, Hip Hop and Musical Theatre – Choreographed by Daisy Cole.

Attached to this letter is the full rehearsal schedule. As ever, involvement in the show will require discipline and commitment to rehearsals, which will take place both in class and on some weekends. We would therefore ask that you ensure your child can attend **all** classes and rehearsals before registering for the show. As you can imagine, a project of this size takes meticulous planning and we need consistency of attendance from all concerned to make sure it is a success. Our primary concern is for our students to have a wonderful experience onstage and this can only be achieved if they feel confident and well rehearsed.

This year, Jazz, Tap, Hip Hop, Contemporary and Musical Theatre Dance Students will rehearse in class, with some extra weekend rehearsals as the show approaches. On Stage Musical Theatre, Ballet Students aged 8 + and others, will rehearse primarily on Saturdays, with a few extra Sunday rehearsals.

The cost for taking part in the show this year will be \$375 for Students Rehearsing in Class (Jazz, Tap, Contemporary, Hip Hop and Musical Theatre Dance) and \$475 for Students on courses not rehearsing in class (Ballet, On Stage MT & MT Intermediate, Theatre Workshop and other students aged 8 +) for which you will receive:

- 1 Full Costume (to the value of \$60)
- 2 Tickets to the show
- At least 40 50 + Hours additional/extra rehearsals
- 15 + Hours Standby Emergency
- Additional Sessions & Individual Calls factored in for gratis

This show fee also helps to contribute to production costs; set, lighting, sound, licensing, insurance, music rights, hire of the theatre and Theatre crew. All remaining costs will be absorbed by Centre Stage.



### A note from Pete re budget:

I would like to add a very brief note re budget. Ali and I believe that the performance element of our work is crucial to the development of the students. It doesn't sit well with us to have to charge dancers to perform; after all, we are performers ourselves and believe that it should be the other way around. Obviously in a training environment however, this simply doesn't add up, as it is impossible to sell enough tickets to finance a show. Theatres in Singapore are very expensive (the one we are in for this show is running close to \$10,000 for just the two days and that is before including all the other costs involved in producing a show.) So, we are just asking for a few things:

- a) Your understanding as to why we have to charge
- b) Your enthusiasm for encouraging friends and family to attend
- c) If any business owner or senior member would like to sponsor us, we are looking for \$5000 to defray costs.

If you are interested in finding out more about the budget, we are very happy to share.

We are passionate about both the benefits of live performance and the education and development of our students; please help us to maintain these opportunities!
