Dear Parents and Students

Putting on any performance requires, line learning, hard work, discipline, commitment, energy and enthusiasm therefore we need to ask the students if they are prepared to commit to this project before we can cast the show and get under way with rehearsals properly. Regular attendance during rehearsals is also of paramount importance both to the success of the rehearsal and to the building of a strong company spirit. So, in order to instil professionalism and responsibility we ask each of the students to think seriously about this undertaking before signing and returning this contract and for the parents to read through all the necessary documents together with your child to understand your role and support in this project.

As we get nearer to the production, we will need extra rehearsals, please see attached rehearsal schedule. Please be prepared to work these extra rehearsals and be on standby for any dates marked as such. Please note that we do NOT charge for extra rehearsals or any standby rehearsals, they stand as added value to the course. The breakdown of the rehearsals is as follows:

Scheduled Rehearsals in Class time	Approx 34 + Hours
Extended Rehearsals (Gratis)	Approx 7 + Hours Approx
Additional Rehearsals (Gratis)	Approx 4 + Hours Approx

Please be prepared to work these extra rehearsals as indicated on the Rehearsal Schedule and be on standby for any dates marked as such.

If you have made or feel you have too many prior commitments that clash with rehearsals – It may be better to opt out of this particular project and then join back again when you have more time to commit - If so please discuss this option with your Child's Teacher. **IMPORTANT to fill in any dates where a prior commitment has been made that clashes with rehearsals.**

Please read carefully and take note of the rehearsal schedule on line before signing the contract and committing to this production.

Please read, sign and return the contract before the next session. The return of these contracts, are necessary for us to be able to continue rehearsals.
